In addition to The Essence, the collective also includes Tyrone the Working Class Hero (www.tyronesmusic.com), Traq Addicc (www.traqaddicc.com), and DJ Kuhnex (www.myspace.com/djkuhnex).

Kuhnex (of High Grade Sound), an international DJ has moved crowds from Port of Spain, Trinidad to Capetown, South Africa. Kuhnex is more than just a button-pressing music player, he's a DJ that knows how to keep the crowd energized and partying all night. Whether spinning his native reggae, soul, or Hip Hop, his presence as a community activist, and precision on the turntables guarantees this crowd favorite's presence as one of the premier DJs in the Pacific Northwest.

Tyrone, known as *the working class hero*, is responsible for the background music in the recent Adidas commercial featuring MLB player JJ Putz. The commercial is part of Adidas' baseball season campaign. The MC/Producer also has his debut album *Heavy Labor, No Breaks* which was released early 2009, has reached fans all the way in Australia.

Traq Addicc (of TAPE), a premier producer from Seattle will be debuting brand new songs from his upcoming release *Love Tape EP*, which features the hit single "[Chillin](#)". Best known for his drums, dynamic choice of sounds and melodic melodies, Traq has solidified his place as a powerhouse Hip-Hop/R&B producer with the sui generis sound. *Love Tape EP* will be released on iTunes April 20th.

The group launched *The Seattle Injection Tour* earlier this month; Seattle was the tour's launching pad.
